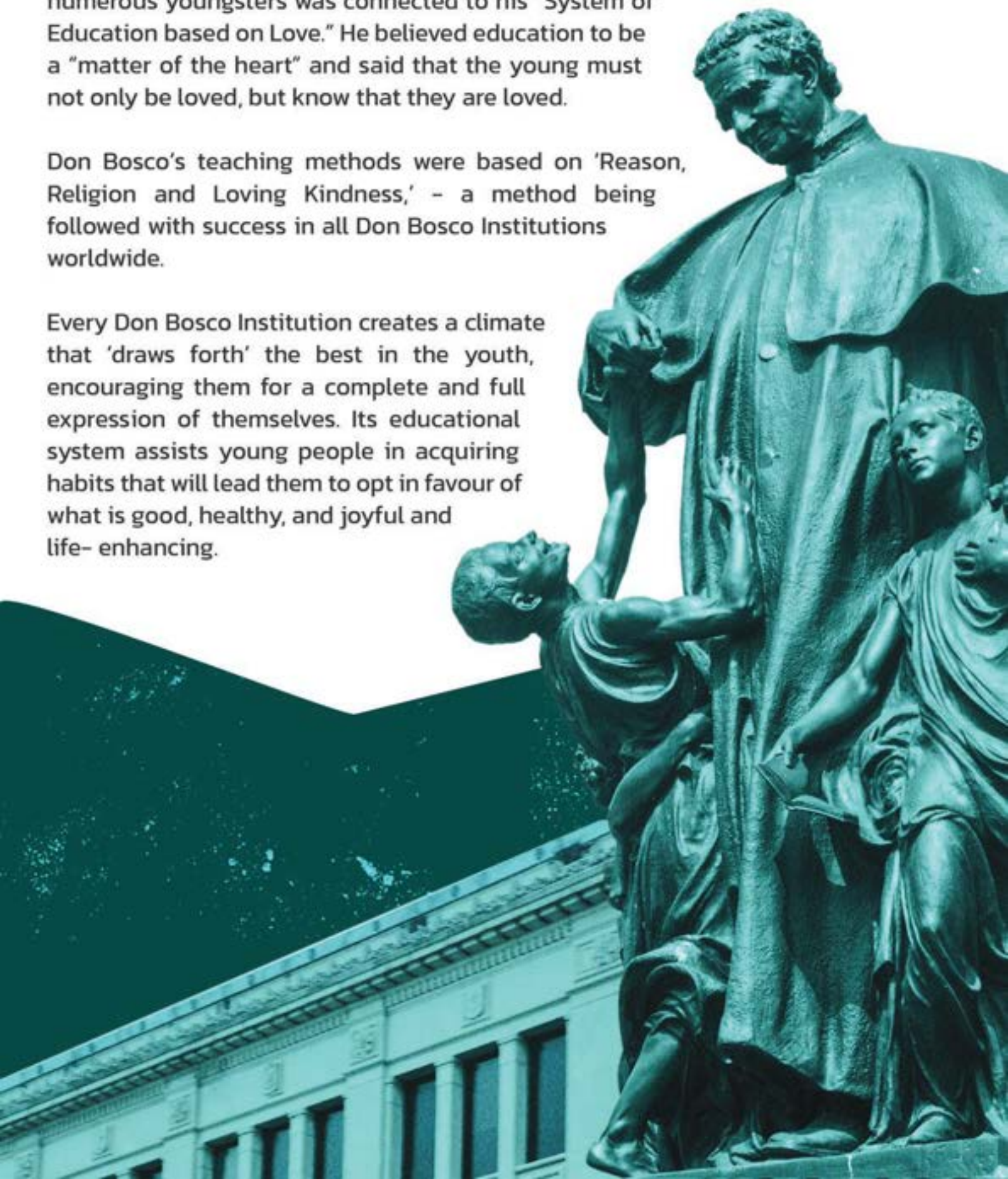


DON BOSCO GROUP OF INSTITUTIONS

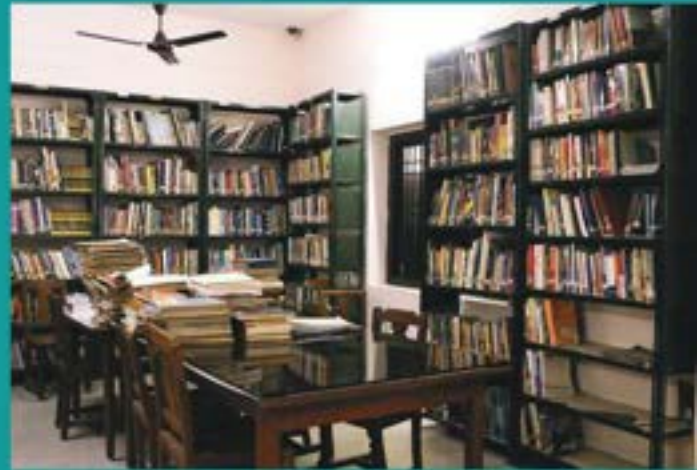
MEDIA CLINIC

CLUBS AND OUTREACH ACTIVITIES

MENTORING

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Applying for Admission

Applicants who have completed the Higher Secondary Examination or any other course recognized by the University of Madras as equivalent to it are eligible for admission to the bachelor degree course. DBCAS welcomes students from other states and countries too.

- Application for admission to B.A / B.Sc. / B.Com can be obtained from the College Office – Admission Department.
- The admission procedure for the Under Graduate Programme will begin 3 days after the publication of the Higher Secondary Examination Results.

Form Submission

- The duly filled in application should reach the college office within ten days from the date of publication of +2/ 12th std results in Tamil Nadu.
- Application form can be submitted in person in the College Office Admissions Department.
- Application form can also be submitted by post with a self-addressed envelope to The Principal, Don Bosco Arts and Science College, No. 45 Landons Road, Kilpauk Chennai – 600010. (College is not responsible for any postal mishap)
- Application form has to be enclosed with the attested documents of the following: The Qualifying Examination Mark sheet
 - Statement of Marks (10th and 12th)
 - Community Certificate
 - Transfer Certificate / Conduct Certificate
 - Medical Certificate
 - Passport Size Photo (5)
 - Certificate of proof for differently abled, sports and Ex-serviceman.
 - Adhaar Card copy
- Any incorrect, false or misleading information in the application form will disqualify the applicant and if already admitted, will lead to the cancellation of his / her admission.

SELECTION PROCESS

- At the time of interview the original documents of all the certificates enclosed with the application should be produced.
- Information regarding interviews for provisionally selected candidates will be sent by Email/SMS. They have to present themselves along with their parents for interviews with the Principal on the date mentioned in the Call Letter. Their absence shall lead to cancellation of Admission.
- No information will be sent to the candidates who have not been selected for the interview.
- An Entrance test for Viscom students (both UG and PG) will be conducted followed by a personal interview.
- Students should produce all the original documents for verification at the time of interview.
- Selected candidates must pay the prescribed fees and submit the original certificates in the College Office.
