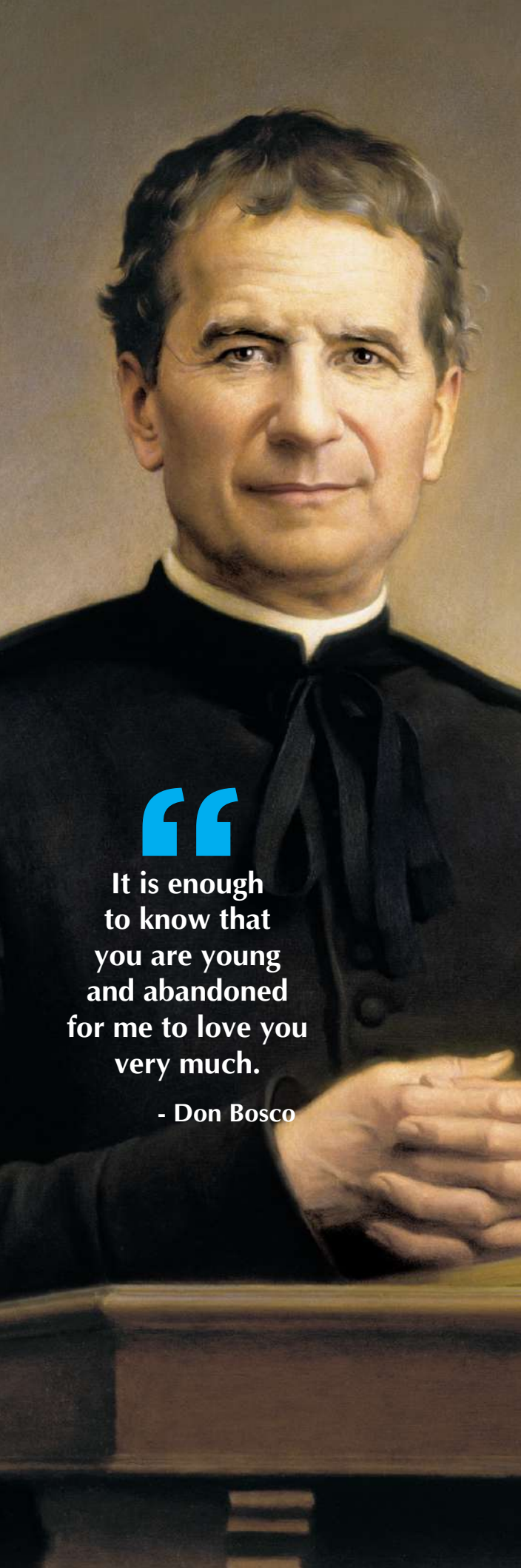

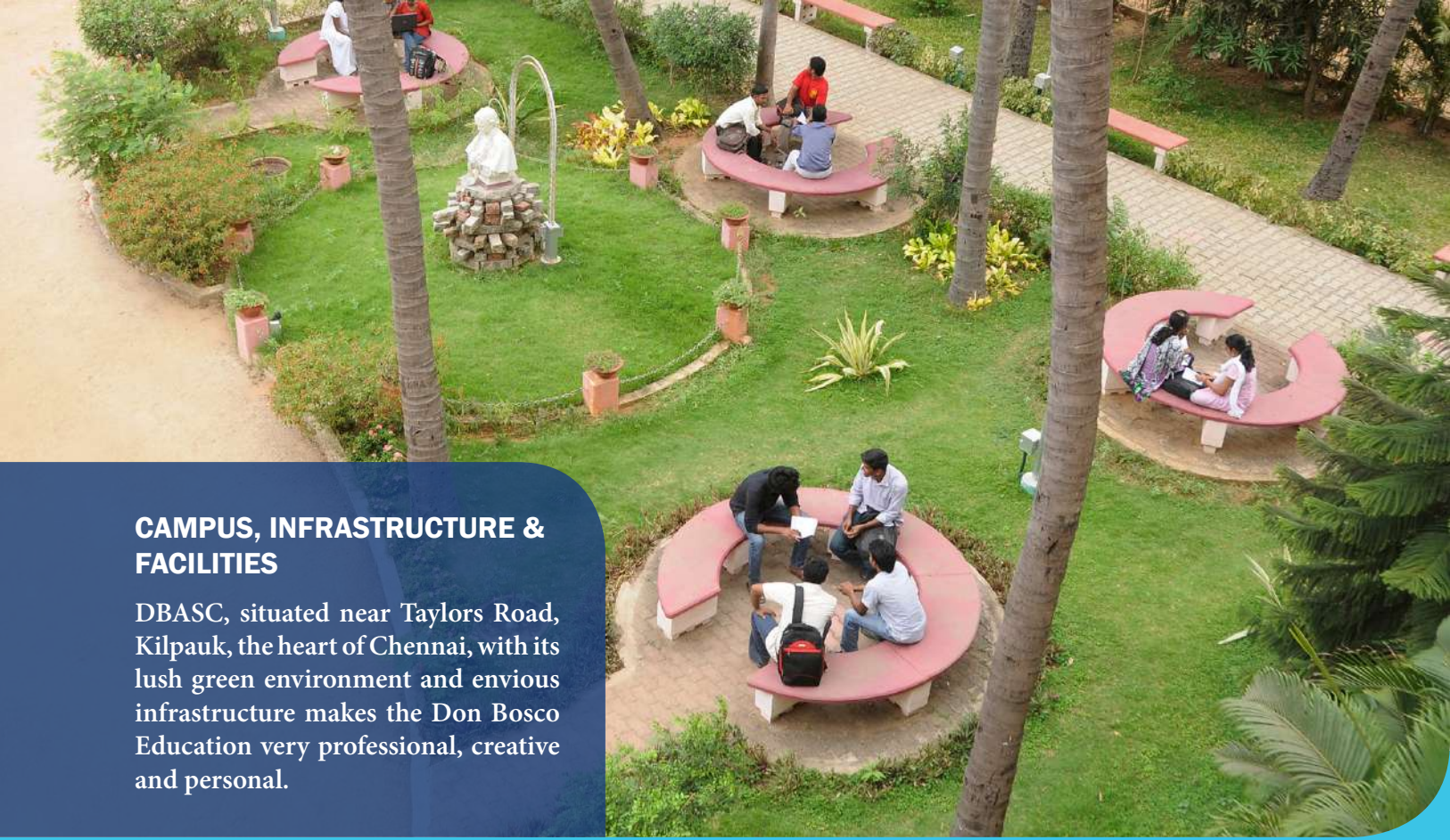

CAMPUS, INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES

DBASC, situated near Taylors Road, Kilpauk, the heart of Chennai, with its lush green environment and enviable infrastructure makes the Don Bosco Education very professional, creative and personal.

LABS

Well-equipped labs with the state-of-the-art equipment and up-to-date software for the various courses make learning and doing very easy and effective. High end animation and graphic designing are also done here. The labs are well maintained and supervised by experienced technicians, facilitating optimum learning and focused honing of one's skills.

CLASSROOMS

The classrooms in DBASC are technology enabled, designed to encourage hands-on learning and to limit passive lectures, fostering a learning-friendly environment. Our class rooms are the ideal place to think outside the box and unleash potentials.

AUDIO - VISUAL STUDIOS

Our Studios are well furnished with in-vogue equipment and edit suites. The Audio Studio is equipped with Pro Tools Audio Workstation and a dubbing studio. The Video Studio is equipped with Final cut Pro (FCP) studio with High Definition Film Editing ambience, and Adobe Premiere edit suites. An Air-conditioned Conference Hall with astounding audio-visual equipment and excellent acoustics is set up for an Avant Garde experience.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

MENTORING

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Candidates who have completed the Higher Secondary Examination or any other course recognized by the University of Madras as equivalent to it are eligible to apply for the Undergraduate course.

- Application for admission to B.A/ B.com/ B.C.A/ B.Sc / M.A/ M.Sc can be obtained from the College office.
- The admission procedure for the Under Graduate programme shall begin 3 days after the publication of the Higher Secondary Examination Results.

FORM SUBMISSION

- The duly filled in application should reach the College office within ten days from the date of publication of +2 / 12th std results in Tamil Nadu.

viii) Any incorrect, false or misleading information in the application form shall disqualify the applicant and if already admitted, will lead to the cancellation of his / her admission.

SELECTION PROCESS

- At the time of interview the original documents of all the certificates enclosed with the application should be produced.
- Information regarding interviews for provisionally selected candidates will be sent by Email / SMS. They have to present themselves along with their parents for interviews with the Principal on the date mentioned in the Call Letter. Their absence shall lead to cancellation of Admission.
- No information will be sent to the candidates who have not been selected for the interview.
- An Entrance test for Viscom students (both UG and PG) will be conducted followed by a personal interview.
- Students should produce all the original documents for verification at the time of interview.
- Selected Candidates must pay the prescribed fees and submit the original certificates at the College Office.
